



Terms and Conditions for Participation in Education Day:

1. Registration and Tickets

All schools must register in advance to participate in the Education Day activities. Tickets purchased are non-refundable but may be transferred to another school if the original registrant is unable to attend. Ticket prices are subject to change; however, prices at the time of booking will be honored.

2. Payment

Full payment must be received prior to the event to secure participation. Accepted payment methods include school-issued purchase orders, credit card payments, and direct bank transfers.

3. Arrival and Departure

Schools are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the event. Schools must adhere to the scheduled arrival and departure times to facilitate smooth operations and ensure full participation in scheduled activities.

4. Supervision

Each school group must be accompanied by an appropriate number of chaperones, adhering to the ratio of at least one adult for every ten students. Chaperones are responsible for the behavior and safety of their students at all times during the event.

5. Conduct

Students and chaperones are expected to behave respectfully and courteously towards all participants, staff, and property. The event organizers reserve the right to remove any person(s) from the event whose behavior is deemed inappropriate.

6. Safety and Accessibility

The event is designed to be accessible to students with disabilities. Schools should notify the event organizers in advance of any specific accessibility needs. All participants must follow safety guidelines and instructions provided by the event staff during activities, especially those involving physical participation.

7. Dietary Needs

Schools must inform the event organizers of any dietary restrictions at least two weeks prior to the event to accommodate these needs. While every effort will be made to meet dietary requirements, the event cannot guarantee that all needs will be fully met.

8. Cancellation by Organizers

In the unlikely event that the Education Day is canceled by the organizers, schools will be notified as soon as possible and offered a full refund or an alternative event date.

9. Photographs and Media

Event organizers may take photographs and recordings during the event for promotional purposes. Schools will be asked to provide a media consent form that must be signed by the parents or guardians of the students attending.

10. Liability

The event organizers are not responsible for personal injuries or damage to personal property during the event. Schools are encouraged to have their own insurance coverage for students and chaperones participating in the event.
